## **Duration of Membership**

- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by Sussex Chamber of Commerce or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your Bank or Building Society If you receive are fund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Sussex Chamber of Commerce asks you to.
