

The group have created a bakery running alongside a tag line "Special bakes made by special people."

They would like to inspire other young people like themselves whilst providing a whole host of tasty treats that they plan to sell through a number of outlets.

Since winning the competition in Gatwick 2016, the JubyLee Bakes team have grown from strength to strength and now selling through a number of outlets across the region including Norwegian Airlines.

In 2019 Jubylee Bakes won lottery funding to help own and kit out their own kitchens in Thakeham, Horsham.
